RESOLUTION: 23-007 VARICK TOWN COUNCIL CALLS FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY STUDY ON NEW

YORK STATE ROUTE 89

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Varick Town Council that the New York State

Department of Transportation has issued a residential highway access permit at or near property

located at 4600 State Route 89, Seneca County tax map 5-1-13.1 in the Town of Varick and

WHEREAS, it appearing from Town records that the intended use of the property may exceed

the definition associated with a residential access permit to a State Highway at the proposed

location and

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes the potential for a significant detriment to public

safety if usage of the proposed State Highway access rises to the level envisioned under plans

submitted to the Town for development at that location, Wherefore, it is

RESOLVED, that the Varick Town Council respectfully requests that the New York State

Department of Transportation further review the residential permit issued for State Highway

access at the above referenced location and that a Highway Safety analysis be conducted to

determine 1) whether the application for a residential access permit is or was appropriate based

upon the high level of usage envisioned under the proposal for development at the site and 2)

whether, in any event such proposed usage constitutes a safety hazard to residents of any such

proposed development and to traffic on State Route 89 at that location.
